NOTICE TO ALL APPLICANTS AND RESIDENTS

REASONABLE ACCOMMODATIONS AND MODIFICATIONS

The Waltham Housing Authority (WHA) is committed to providing equal access to housing for all applicants and residents, including individuals with disabilities. Under the Federal Fair Housing Act, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, and the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), individuals with disabilities may request reasonable accommodations or structural modifications that enable full enjoyment and participation in WHA programs and housing.

Reasonable Accommodation: A change in policy, procedure, or practice—example: live-in aide approval, alternative communication, extended deadlines.

Reasonable Modification: A physical change to a unit or common area—example: grab bars, ramps, visual alarms.

Request Process: Requests may be made verbally or in writing. Documentation may be required if need is not obvious.

Confidentiality: All disability-related information will remain confidential and shared only with staff responsible for processing the request.
